

Student Drop Off & Staff Parking Lot
<p>Please make sure you are using our drop off zone for student pick up and drop off. The parking lot is designated for Staff Parking only. It is important we work together in keeping our students safe and minimizing traffic in the parking lot. Please keep the bus zone clear during morning drop off and after school pick up.</p> <p>To ensure traffic safety, please use the marked crosswalk to cross the street. During pick up and drop off there is a lot of traffic in front of the school. Crossing the street between vehicles or buses is extremely dangerous.</p> <p>Parking at the school is challenging. We ask that you avoid parking in front of the school as this area is for buses only.</p> <p>Please continue to assist us by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not parking in the bus zones in front of the school during school hours. • Using the HUG ZONE from 8:00-8:15am to minimize parking. • Not using the staff parking lot. • Not parking on private property or the school next door. • REMEMBER, there is a 30km/hr. speed limit in front of our school for your child's safety. • U turns at the crosswalk and in front of the school are illegal. City bylaw has been in the area monitoring traffic. • Please use sidewalks and avoid walking through parking lots or jaywalking.
Communication
<p>Open and positive communication between the home and the school is one of the most important contributions we can make for the educational development of children.</p> <p>Should you need to meet with the teacher or the administration outside of the designated Celebrations of Learning which will be scheduled throughout the year, please phone or e-mail to book an appointment.</p> <p>A Family Week-at-a-Glance will be emailed every Friday to our families with important information about the upcoming week and important information for families.</p> <p>Please ensure the office has your correct email address to receive the newsletter. Special announcements will be sent home with your child when necessary.</p>

Medical Conditions & Administering Medication

Please visit the office to complete the necessary forms for any medical conditions your child may have and for administering any medication they require while at school. We will not administer any medication without the proper forms and permissions.

Allergies

There are students and staff members who have life-threatening peanut, tree-nuts and other allergies. It is important that as a community we strive to be a nut and allergy aware school and that together we take all the reasonable precautions not to have known allergens in the school. Please check ingredients and do not bring any foods to the school that have peanuts, nuts, other known allergens, or that have been produced in places that there could have been possible contamination.

When choosing to send treats for your child's birthday please consider sending a non-food item to be inclusive of all students and promote safety within our school.

As per Edmonton Catholic School Division AP, point 2.4.4 parents are asked to provide the school with two up-to-date applications of the student's appropriate medication, one for the safe access storage space and one to be carried by the student. Please call the school office if you have any questions.

Classroom Treats (Birthdays & Special Events)

When we celebrate birthdays and special events in our classrooms, we want to ensure the safety and well-being of all members of our community. We have many members within our school community with severe allergies, and it is important that we take precautions to protect everyone.

If you send a treat to share, please make sure that it meets the following guidelines:

- The treat must be purchased at a store.
- It should not contain peanuts or other tree nuts.
- There must be an ingredient list included.
- Individually packaged treats are preferred.


Please contact your child's classroom teacher to inform them that you will be sending in a snack/treat and specify what the treat is.

If your child has an allergy or food intolerance, please connect with their homeroom teacher to let us know what treats would be safe for your child. Your cooperation helps us create a safe and inclusive environment for everyone.
